Requirements for Appointment

- Be a Kenyan Citizen
- Be a holder of at least first degree in the relevant field from a university recognized in Kenya
- A Masters Degree will be an added advantage
- Have relevant knowledge and working experience of not less than ten (10) years, 5 of which must have been in a managerial position in Public Service or Private Sector in the portfolio applied for.
- Demonstrate a thorough understanding of Devolution, the County Development Plan and Vision 2030.
- Be a strategic thinker and results oriented.
- Proven Experience in Public Finance Management.
- Have a thorough knowledge of the County.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Satisfy the requirements of Chapter Six of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 on leadership and integrity
- Membership of a relevant professional body will be an added advantage
- Ability to mobilize resources (proposal writing)
