A. DIRECTOR PLANNING AND ADMINISTRATION- REF NO: EMCPSB/06/15-(1 position

The Director of Health planning and administration shall be in charge of all Health support functions including Planning Unit, HR, Finance, health information, and supply chain management and will be reporting to the Chief Officer of Health Services.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- The officer will be in charge of County health planning, HR administration, accounting and finance for health, logistics, procurement and health information.
- Holds administrative meetings, writes reports and supervises administrative matters
- Is responsible for taking and keeping of minutes of the County Health Management Team subject to the directions of the Chief Officer of Health.
- Prepares Budgets, manages and supports revenue collection and prepares regular financial reports for health department
- Ensures proper coordination, monitoring and evaluation of the activities as detailed in the County Health Sector Strategic and Investment Plan
- Follows up activities in the county health annual work plans.
- Carries out audit and accounting reports for the health facilities in the county and the County Health Management Teams
- Prepares AIE for health facilities and monitors their spending to ensure that it conforms to County Treasury
- Ensures efficient management and coordination of County Health Management administrative activities.
- Performs any other duties as directed by the County Chief Officer of Health.

- Supervises and promotes development of the staff within his/her jurisdiction
- Monitors and reviews medical health services.
- Provides leadership and stewardship for overall medical health management in the county
- Facilitates and implements national medical services programs

- Coordinates the referral functions across all levels of facilities in the county
- Ensures delivery of quality medical services and adheres to the national and county health plans, policies, guidelines and standards
- Ensures regular supportive supervision to medical service delivery points in the county
- Any other duties as may be assigned Chief Officer of Health from time to time

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Overall planning, direction and development of public health and sanitation services
- Ensures consistent administration of public health policies and procedures and implementation of the Health Sector Strategic and Investment Plan in matters concerning Public and Environmental Health
- Shall be in charge of public health and sanitation programs domain and ensures management of programs within the budget.
- Ensures advocacy for healthier life style, chronic disease management and control through community strategy and outreaches

- Ensure administration of laws and regulations including International Health that protects environmental and public safety
- Prepares proposals for resource mobilization, identifies relevant partners and agencies in support of public health programs and projects
- Initiates the development of modern Information Communication and Technology in provision of public health and sanitation services.
- Oversees administration of County Health Sector Strategic Plan, County Integrated Development Plan and supports officers under him/her to ensure performance targets are achieved
- Manages and coordinates the licensing and control of all undertakings that sell food to the public
- Is in charge of the management and maintenance of all cemeteries, funeral parlors and crematorium
- Ensures proper and timely solid and liquid waste management and maintenance of refuse dumps
- Diagnoses and investigates Environmental Health problems and epidemiological hazards in the community
- Mobilizes community participation to identify and solve health problems, and promotes staff development, coaching and mentoring.
- Performs any other duties as may be assigned by the supervisor
