

**REPORT OF ITEN MUNICIPALITY 1ST QUARTER CITIZEN FOR A HELD FROM
19TH – 20TH SEPTEMBER,2024 FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2023/2024**

INTRODUCTION

The meetings for the 1st quarter citizen Foras was held at KMTC Hall in Iten, Bugar Centre, Katalel Centre and Kessup.

The objective of these citizen Foras was Prioritization and approval of Kenya Urban Support Programme (KUSP) projects FY 2023/2024

OVERVIEW OF CONCERNS AND PRIORITIES FROM THE RESIDENTS

The members of the Public were given opportunity to express their views on the proposed projects and they raised their concerns as indicated below:

- i. Improvement of urban roads/informal settlements to Bitumen standards
- ii. Storm water drainage in Iten Municipality.
- iii. Pedestrian walkways.
- iv. Street/security lighting
- v. Solid waste collection/sorting-purchase of skip loaders ,skip containers and litter bins
- vi. Public parks and green spaces
- vii. Encroachment of footpaths on the CBD areas.
- viii. Improvement of Public Toilets
- ix. Skip Trailer
- x. Construction of Collection Point
- xi. A concern was raised on designated areas for disposing of waste whereby a resident wanted to where exactly was the designated area.
- xii. General nuisance of matatu operators at Iten
- xiii. Noise nuisance by Jua Kali industry i.e welding
- xiv. Conflicting businesses such as an hotel adjacent to a barber and therefore need for zoning to ensure compatibility of businesses
- xv. The pay bill numbers for paying parking fees to county revenue offices to be displayed in visible areas to ease payment
- xvi. A resident wanted to know the duration it takes before a vehicle is clamped by enforcement officers
- xvii. A resident wanted to know the entity responsible in provision of waste disposal container at residential areas.
- xviii. Hawking by traders from Eldoret in Iten hence hindering the businesses of those who have paid for Business licenses at iten.
- xix. A resident suggested that a central bus park be provided with a single tout to curb emerging conflicts among matatu Saccos

- xx. A grace period be provided for businesses initiated at the last quarter of the year
- xxi. Scarcity of public toilets at the municipality CBD
- xxii. Scarcity of public land for development since most of it had been grabbed.
- xxiii. A resident wanted to know whether the issue beautification was captured in the by-laws
- xxiv. Most drainage in Iten CBD are open posing accident risks to boda bodas and other road users.
- xxv. Poor drainage at Iten field, leading to health hazards.
- xxvi. A concern was raised on fencing of Iten field
- xxvii. A resident wanted to know whether the municipality has a record of foreign athletes visiting Iten Municipality

WAY FORWARD

After harmonizing all the identified projects raised by the various stakeholders and consideration of the budget available, a consensus was reached that the following projects be implemented:

- i) Improvement of Public Toilets
- ii) Construction of Collection Point
- iii) Skip Trailer
