During the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter, the total cumulative revenue amounted to Kshs. **948,015,345** against an approved budget of Kshs **5,020,012,841** representing 19% achievement. The actual local revenues amounted to Ksh.31,144,600 against a budgeted target of Kshs **130,000,000**.

The total expenditure amounted to Kshs **612,138,673** against an approved budget of Kshs **5,020,012,841**, representing 12% of total expenditure against the total budget. The absorption rate for recurrent expenditures and Development Expenditure stood at 20% and 0% respectively. Payment of in respect to development projects was not made in Qtr 1.

#### STATEMENT OF MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES

The CEC member for finance accepts responsibility for the County Government's financial statements, which have been prepared on the Cash Basis Method of Financial Reporting, using appropriate accounting policies in accordance with International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSAS). The CEC member for finance is of the opinion that this report gives a true and fair view of the state of the County Government's transactions during the quarter ended 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2018, and of its financial position as at that date. The CEC member for finance further confirms the completeness of the accounting records maintained for the County Government which have been relied upon in the preparation of this report as well as the adequacy of the systems of internal financial control.

The CEC member for finance confirms that the County Government has complied fully with applicable Government Regulations and the terms of external financing covenants (where applicable), and that the County Government's funds received during the quarter under audit were used for the eligible purposes for which they were intended and were properly accounted for. Further the CEC member for finance confirms that the County Government's financial statements have been prepared in a form that complies with relevant accounting standards prescribed by the Public Sector Accounting Standards Board of Kenya.
